

We start with the Witnesses in the catacombs agreeing they must keep the fact that they are from the future under wraps from Betsy Ross. If they don't, they run the risk throwing the time stream into chaos. Betsy is suspicious, but Ichabod tells her they are on a rescue mission and pushes forward. Ichabod recites the incantation and the box is reformed but does not have the silver hue. It seems the box needs a soul of a Witness. A black cloud snakes out of the box and embraces Abbie. Betsy gets the box shut, and at first Abbie seems fine, but then collapses. When she awakes she is weak and can tell something is wrong. Ichabod explains what happened and promises they will fix it.

Back in the real world, Jenny tells Abbie and Ichabod about Joe, but there's no time to mourn because they need to destroy the Hidden One. Jenny has found research where gods were killed in the Norse Ragnarok—The Twilight of the Gods. With Ezra's help, they find the Elder Edda. If there's a clue on how to destroy him, it's in there.

At FBI headquarters, Jenny and Abbie talk with Reynolds and Sophie. A freak storm has popped up over the Hudson Valley, and they know who's at the center.

Jenny and Abbie go at the Hidden One from the front with Greek Fire while Ichabod gives Pandora the box. She opens it and it starts to destroy the Hidden One but stops half way. The process was stopped in the catacombs, so the box is not at full power. Pandora tells Abbie she is still holding on to hope, and she must give herself to it completely. To save the world, Abbie opens the box. Ichabod yells, but it's too late. She tells him never to give up hope, her final words and then is sucked into the box.

The Hidden One and Pandora are left behind, but his powers are gone. Pandora tells him to beg for forgiveness, but before he can, Jenny shoots him. Pandora is outraged the victory was taken from her and proclaims herself a goddess now that she has all of the Hidden One's power. Headless and Pandora fight but its soon apparent Pandora is stronger. The Horseman cannot defeat her alone. Ichabod runs to help, but Pandora stops him in his tracks. Jenny rushes to his side. Crane disperses over losing Abbie and Jenny reminds him that she sacrificed herself so he could save the day. Ichabod rallies and tosses the Horseman his axe. He quickly gives Pandora a bloody end, but before she dies Ichabod orders her to set Abbie free. With her dying breath Pandora tells him she was never in the box, she's dead.

With Pandora dead, the box explodes and sends Ichabod into a 'waiting room' between life and death where he sees Abbie. She explains that the box took her soul; with it destroyed she's free. But they are eternal souls so she can't go into the light. Ichabod questions her about this, but Abbie has no answers. Only that she's done what she needed to do with him and it's time for the next stage, but they will meet again. With a kiss on the hand and a bow, Ichabod says his goodbye and Abbie is gone.

Jenny wakes Ichabod, but can tell Abbie won't be coming back this time.

A short time passes, and Ichabod visits Abbie's grave. He catches her up on what's been going on and informs her that he's in charge of the archives and moving forward with his citizenship. As he's about to leave, Ezra shows up and hands him a note from George Washington dated 1789.

In a flashback, we see Washington talking with Betsy. He explains how hundreds of years from now Ichabod will be in charge of a secret organization set on fighting the supernatural.

Abbie's death has set wheels in motion. When a Witness dies, their soul can't move on so it is passed to another in their bloodline. There must always be two Witnesses. Ezra tells Ichabod he must find this person before 'they' do.

As he says this, three black SUV's come rushing toward them. Ezra makes a quick get away as Ichabod is approached by FBI agent Jack Waters, asking him to escort him to DC where some people are eager to talk to him. Before Ichabod goes he claims, "I will find you."
